Injury & Incident Investigation Policy

Policy brief & purpose

Elite Project Solutions (EPS) records all injuries on the Register of Injuries.

Where the injury requires medical attention or off-site treatment, EPS completes an Incident Investigation Report.

Copies of Incident Investigation Reports are provided to the principal contractor, as required.

Injuries:

All injuries are reported to the designated First Aid Officer in the workplace.

Incidents:

For all incidents involving near misses, property/plant damage or injury to the public or the environment, **EPS** investigates and records the details in an Incident Investigation Report.

Copies of completed Incident Investigation Reports are provided to the principal contractor, as required.

Notifiable Incidents:

EPS reports all notifiable incidents to the relevant Authority.

Where such an incident has occurred, **EPS** considers whether the site needs to be preserved for investigation by the relevant Authority.

Record Keeping:

EPS keeps records of incidents and injuries in accordance with statutory requirements.

APPROVED:

This Policy will be reviewed every 12 months to ensure its appropriateness, accuracy and value.

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
