Supply Chain Responsibility:

Preventative Measures:

We undertake preventative measures to eliminate modern slavery practices within our supply chains and operations, emphasising our proactive role in upholding human rights and ethical business practices.

Legal Compliance:

EPS commits to complying with relevant legislation and human rights obligations, taking decisive action to respond to the humanitarian impacts of modern slavery.
